Submission Rules

1. Films from or about India, with or without an Indian theme, made by Indian and international filmmakers, produced in 2008 or later and films that have not had a public screening in Los Angeles are eligible to be submitted.
2. Filmmakers may submit more than one entry. Each entry must be accompanied by the entry form and an entry fee. Entry fees are not refundable.
3. Please send your submission in DVD format, preferably in NTSC.
4. Submission DVDs must be labeled with the title, running time, format (PAL or NTSC) and contact information.
5. Submission DVDs will not be returned.
6. If your film is selected, you will be required to provide 10 DVD (NTSC) screeners, and a press kit with press reviews, synopsis, full credits, film stills, director's filmography and headshot, posters, and clips from the film or a trailer.
7. All filmmakers will be notified via email by **March 1, 2010**.

Complete the form on the first page, print it out, sign it, and send it with a DVD and the submission fee. If you are paying with Pay Pal, please remember to indicate the title of your film in the relevant field.
